As you begin your college search, you join an increasingly large number of New York state high school graduates seeking a college education. There is little doubt that a college education is more essential than ever. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, two in every five jobs created in the coming decade will require a college degree. (In 2000, less than one-third of jobs required higher education.)

When you consider colleges to attend, think about the kind of learning environment you want, and the value of your future degree. At New York's private colleges and universities, you'll benefit from your contacts with world-class faculty and alumni; you'll have opportunities to gain real-life experience; and you'll enjoy the pleasure of forming personal relationships with professors who come to know you, your interests and your talents.

Collectively, New York's private colleges and universities continue to increase access and educate students from all income and demographic groups. We strive to enable students to attend the college of their choice and help New York State stretch its higher education dollar. Our campuses are attracting more students of color: one in four enrolled students is African-American, Asian, or Hispanic, nearly double the percentage enrolled in 1980.

It is important to know that there is assistance available to help meet college expenses. Currently, seven out of every 10 full-time students receive financial assistance. And, each year, New York's Independent Sector devotes nearly \$1.7 billion to scholarships and grants for students.

I urge you to explore all your options, ask lots of questions, and visit campuses. You are sure to find the New York private college or university that's right for you.

How to Begin Your College Search

There are many things to consider as you look at different colleges: academic programs, the quality of the college, the sense of community it offers and campus life, its geographic location, and, of course, college costs and financial aid. This booklet guides you through the college selection process by providing the information you need to make an informed decision.

So where do you begin your college search?

- Start with this guide. If you have an idea about what you want to study, go to the Academic Programs section (pages 4-17) which lists bachelor's and associate degree programs offered by private colleges and universities in New York State.
- Use the Search Worksheet in the center of this guide to compile a list of colleges that match your interests. Find out more about them. The Map (pages 2-3) pinpoints geographic locations, and the Campus Profiles section (pages 18-32) will give you basic information about the colleges on your list.
- Attend college fairs. You can talk with college representatives and pick up literature. Finding, evaluating, and choosing a college requires thought, planning, and information. Keep an open mind. You'll discover a college that suits you.
- To receive more information about any college in this booklet, fill out the Request for college Information card in the center of this guide, or use the on-line form at www.nycolleges.org/register.html.
- High school juniors and seniors should visit colleges that interest them. Before you visit, make an appointment to meet with faculty in areas that match your academic interests. While you're there, take the official tour, walk around and talk with students.

Maybe you have a very specific academic interest. Perhaps you're still searching. Either way, there's a New York state private college or university that's right for you.

- Early on, begin to investigate sources of financial aid. Refer to the pages in the center of this guide for ways to get started.
- By fall of your senior year, shorten your college list to between five and eight choices.
- If possible, talk with current students or graduates of these colleges. Ask your school counselor and the colleges' admission counselors for the contact names of students or alumni.
- Obtain admissions and financial aid forms. Fill out the forms carefully and *be sure to meet all deadlines*.

Finding, evaluating, and choosing a college requires thought, planning, and information. Keep an open mind. You'll discover a college that suits you.

These straightforward steps will help you get started. This is an exciting time in your life. It may be challenging, but the time you put into the process can help you find the college that's best for you.

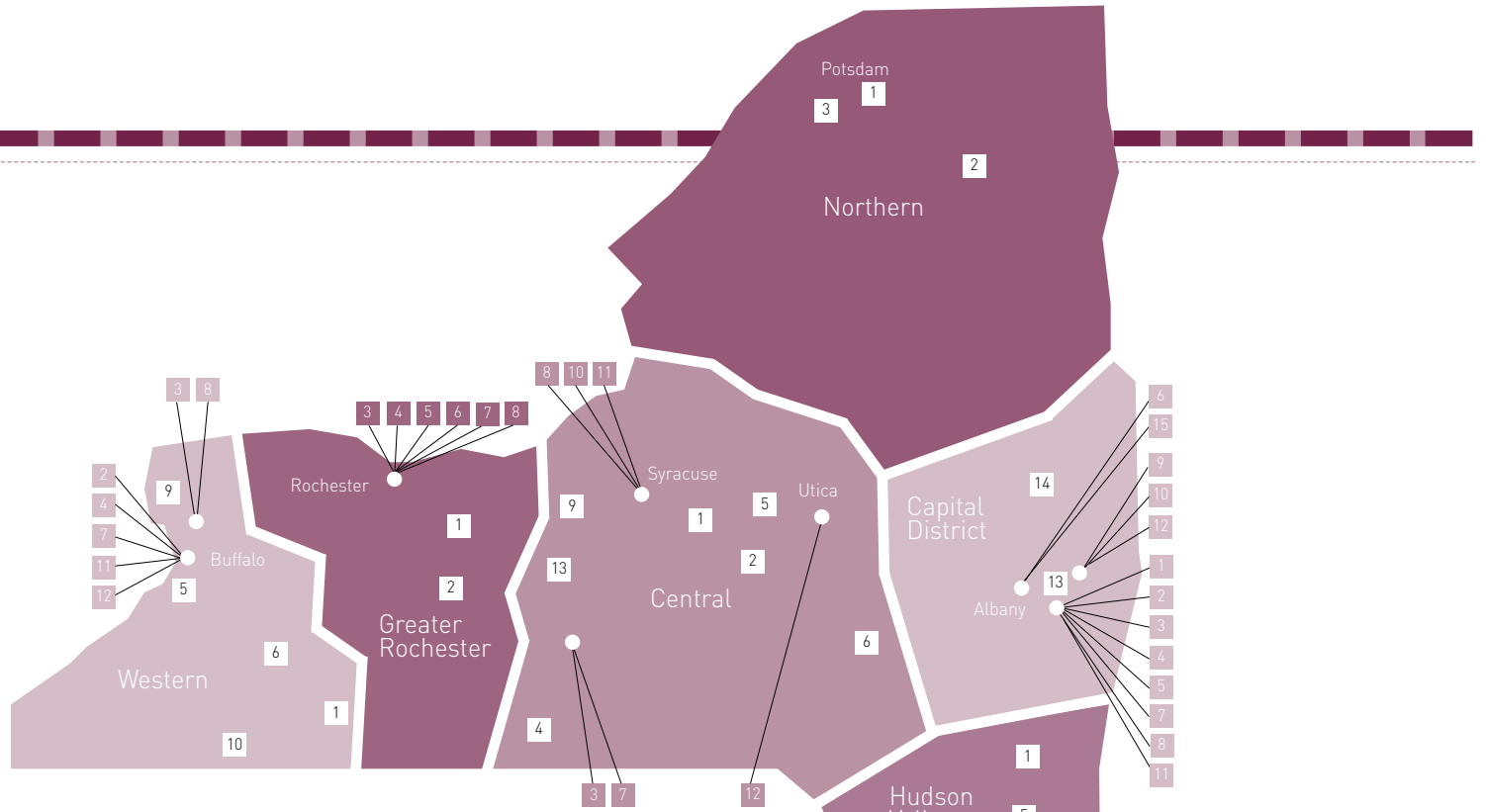

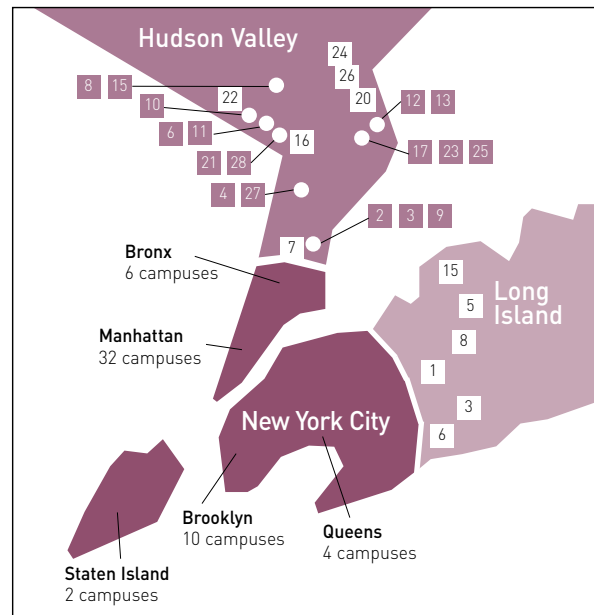
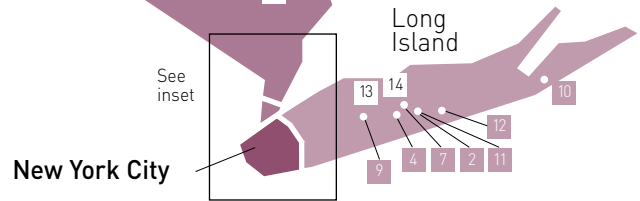

Academic Programs

How to use the Academic Programs Listing

Scan the areas of study at right to locate those that interest you. Each is followed by page numbers where you'll find bachelor's (B) and/or associate (A) degree program listings. For example, let's say you're interested in a bachelor's degree in French. Programs in Foreign Languages are listed on page 10. The programs are numbered and cross-referenced to the colleges and universities. Look for French, number 6. Next, look down the list of colleges. Highlight or circle all the colleges with number 6. You should find 45 colleges that offer a degree program, a minor, or major area of concentration in French.

The Academic Programs section is a general listing. It includes a broad range of the undergraduate degree programs, minors and major areas of concentration offered by New York's private colleges and universities. **Always consult individual campus catalogues to distinguish registered degree programs from minors and major areas of concentration offered within larger programs.**

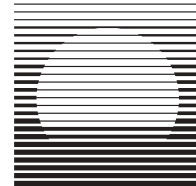
